In the challenge of bringing students to have competency in English as an international language, teachers and educators must be ready to adapt to the various kinds of changes that occur. Ultimately high-quality professional development serves to develop educators' knowledge, attitudes, skills, aspirations, and behavior, so that they can, in turn, apply what they have learned to improve practice in the hope that student learning can increase (Guskey, 2000). Teachers are more likely to apply new practices well if they receive support while experimenting in class. When a professional development program is designed, an important factor to consider is the duration and intensity of the program. Despite the efforts made to improve teaching especially in secondary schools, the results have, so far, been unsatisfactory (Sadtono, 1976; Djiwandono, 1983; Danifil 1985). In 52 student mastery programs, English was found to be a barrier for students to complete their studies on time (Kasbolah and Sukarnyana, 1993). This condition may be remedied by means of autonomy learning, "a learning situation that implies the capacity to exercise control over one's own learning" (Nunan, 2000).

Learning refers to two activities, namely learning and teaching. Learning activities are related to students, while teaching activities are related to what the teacher does. As revealed by Munib Chatib, the two-way process of transferring knowledge, between the teacher as the provider of information and the student as the recipient of information is called learning. While Achjar Chalil (Zulvina Trinova: 2012) provides a definition that learning is a process of interaction between students and educators and learning resources in a learning environment. Meanwhile, Arief S Sadiman stated that learning the process of delivering messages from message sources to message recipients through certain channels or media is called learning (Arief S. Sadiman, et al., 1990, p. 11).

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From the definitions above, it can be concluded that learning contains three important factors, namely: learning resources, the process planned by educators, and students who learn. The process in which there are interaction activities between educators and students as well as reciprocal communication that takes place in educational situations in order to achieve learning objectives is called the learning process (Rustaman, 2001: 461). In the learning process, educators and students are two components that are interrelated and cannot be separated. Between these two components, mutually supportive interactions must be established so that student learning outcomes can be maximally achieved. As for the learning process, namely all joint efforts between educators and students to share and process information, with the hope that the knowledge provided can be of use value to students and become a basis for continuous learning, and it is expected to realize better changes to achieve an increase, positive which begins with changes in individual behavior for the creation of an efficient and effective teaching and learning process. A positive learning process will shape the ability to think critically, intellectually, and create creativity and personal change or a person's behavior based on certain experiences or practices that have been carried out.

Learning is interesting and fun if there is a relaxed atmosphere, there is no pressure, feels safe, increases interest in learning, students are fully involved, students have attention poured out, have an attractive learning environment, are full of enthusiasm, cause feelings of joy, create high concentration. Indrawati, M.Pd and Drs. Wawan Setiawan, 2009, p. 24).

Various ways that educators can produce fun learning include doing ice breaking when the learning process feels saturated or monotonous, using various teaching methods, creating an atmosphere. who are relaxed, educators are able to provide motivation to students, and greet students enthusiastically and warmly. In the context of a pleasant learning process the teacher is

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required not only to play himself as an educator or teacher, but also as a motivator as well as a facilitator for students.

In the second half of the 19th century polemic about the teaching of foreign languages gave birth to the Reformation Movement, which consisted of ideas to reform the old school system (Tamura, 2006: 173). The teaching of English as a second language represents a major thrust. In the last decades of the 19th century as a consequence of economic problems in Europe more and more people were trying to find a way of life in the United States, Australia and Canada. He considered that the reading material given in class must consist of dialogue and related texts. All descriptions and narratives should be easy and natural and attractive. Meanwhile, the search for a new path was continued. The polemic about foreign language teaching goes hand in hand with the idea of reforming the old school system. In "mother tongue" classes, exclusion is almost complete when teaching English. Conception imitating sounds and pronouncing words and sentences when heard becomes much more profound and important. Methods that do not use mediation from the mother tongue occur. In this case as the mother tongue is completely excluded from teaching, no translation is used. This means that the words are explained using direct intuition, a representation through existing pictures associated with foreign words. Abstract thoughts are explained by paraphrasing, by synonym or antonym or simply by deducing the meaning from the text. Correct pronunciation rules are very important and grammar is secondary. Grammar is achieved by practice. Students are given text instead of unrelated sentences to prove certain grammar rules. In 1878 the direct method was applied by M.D. Berlitz and in the 20th century this method was introduced in many schools. However, initially using this method is not easy, students need to get used to independent work and at the same time, the meaning of the words taught by this direct method is not always

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understood. The direct method came up with several names such as reform method, new method, and oral method. This direct method does not always have to be used in teaching special subjects or courses in English. But it can be used in all subjects or lectures. Such as opening and closing classes in English, or training students to use English when making presentations, at least for opening and closing presentations. Using the language of instruction in English at every class meeting even though it is not one hundred percent will greatly help improve the use of English skills.
